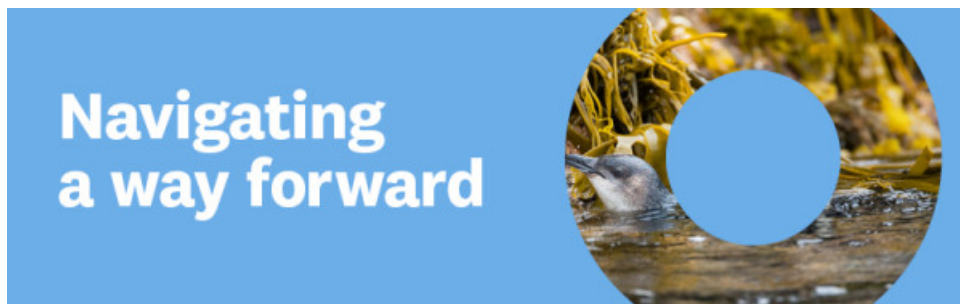

- How we manage our reliance on external funding
- How we meet future legislative requirements regarding three waters
- Our inability to invest in critical infrastructure
- A potential rates rise
