Chatham Islands Transfer Stations

What can be recycled?



Plastic bottles & containers



Tin & aluminium cans & glass bottles



Scrap metal



E-waste (batteries, stereos, TVs, computers, whiteware)

What's accepted

Refuse: Household/commercial waste

Paper/cardboard: Flattened and tied in a bundle please

Recycling: clean glass bottles, tin/aluminum cans, plastic bottles/containers

Reusable resources: tyres, wood, building materials, fishing rope, waste oil

Scrap Metal: under 25 kgs, if over Philippa and Noel will receive it. Ph: 194. Fence wire must be in tidy coils.

All items must be rinsed and clean.

What's not accepted

- Greenwaste
- Offal, kaimoana, bones, animal bodies
- Car bodies
- Oversize loads eg: trucks must be arranged with staff before arrival please on Ph: 033

Mitre 12 at Te One accepts: used clothing, household goods, toys, books, old fixtures, renovation materials, bikes, furniture, tools.

Just drop off or pick up for reuse. **Please leave in a tidy state for our community.**

How do I recycle?

Rinse and drop at your nearest transfer station



We're counting on you

Unlike most New Zealand councils, we do not charge for refuse disposal. Instead, we rely on the goodwill of the community to assist where they can in the reduction of waste to landfill.

A free **recycling crate** is available to every household. This is to assist in separating recyclable resources from refuse (rubbish going to landfill). If you have not collected your recycling crate yet, please call into the Council office to collect one. Replacement crates are available for \$15.

Until our shed and equipment (baler/glass crusher) are operational, systems cannot operate fully. We appreciate your patience during this **transition period** and tolerance during this period. Refuse will then be baled and placed in the new landfill.
