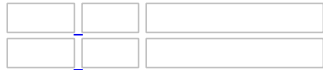

We carry out animal control functions on the Chatham Islands, including the control of stock on public roads, dogs and other domestic animals.

We are guided by the [Dog Control Act 1996\(external link\)](#), the [Impounding Act 1995\(external link\)](#) and the [Chatham Islands Dog Control Bylaw 2017 \[PDF, 4 MB\]](#) The Council also has a [Dog Control Policy \[PDF, 342 KB\]](#) which provides guidance on how to apply the bylaw.

Dog registration: \$66

Early dog registration: \$42

Fines under Dog Control Act 1996 – vary from \$100 up to \$750 depending on offence, as per [Schedule 1 of the Dog Control Act 1996\(external link\)](#)

Impounding fee: \$112
